ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Attendance matters for achieving school success beginning in Kindergarten. Absences can add up before you know it! As a parent, you are responsible for making sure your child develops the habit of regular attendance. If you are facing any challenges, seek support from the school and community. WE ARE HERE TO HELP!

Your children can suffer academically if they miss more than 18 school days, which is equivalent to one day every two weeks, that can happen very quickly if attendance is not closely monitored.

At Wright, our goal is for every student to attend school 95% of the time, which means that a student cannot be absent more than 9 times in the school year. When students are in school, we are able to support them academically and set them up for success!!!
